**Aaron  
Broten**

Totaled 515 points (186-359) in 748 career NHL games; Holds single-season records for points (106), points by a rookie (72) and assists (59) at the University of Minnesota; WCHA Freshman of the Year in 1980.



**Bobby  
Carpenter**

First player in history to make the jump directly from high school to the NHL; First American-born player to score 50 goals in a season; Ranks third all-time among American-born players in NHL games played (1,178); Compiled 728 points (320-408) in NHL career.



**John  
MacInnes**

Retired in 1982 as the winningest college hockey coach in history with 552 wins after 26 years at Michigan Tech University; Led Huskies to three NCAA national championships (1962, 1965, 1975) and seven WCHA titles; Two-time NCAA Coach of the Year (1970 & 1976).



**John  
Vanbiesbrouck**

Holds NHL records for most wins (374) and most games played (882) by an American-born goaltender; Vezina Trophy winner (1986); Three-time NHL All Star (1994, 1996, 1997); Member of 1998 U.S. Olympic Men's Ice Hockey Team.
