

Naperville North Huskies Hockey Club Locker Boxing Policy

The Naperville North Huskies Hockey Club (the "Club") prohibits "locker boxing" (i.e. boxing in the locker room with participants wearing helmet and gloves) or any other form of wrestling or fighting in the Club's locker room or elsewhere. Activities of this nature are potentially dangerous, serve no useful purpose and may be a form of intimidation.

Any member of the Club, including coaches, managers, parents or players, who becomes aware of an instance of "locker boxing" or similar conduct should report the incident to the Board or a Board member. The Club expects team captains, as part of their leadership responsibilities, to prevent these activities from occurring in the locker rooms. If participants persist, then the team captain will inform the head coach.

The Club will not tolerate "locker boxing" in any form. If a Club player engages in "locker boxing" or similar conduct, he/she will be subject to disciplinary action under the Club's Grievance Procedures, including possible dismissal from the team.
