

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

**All new skaters start in level 1. Skaters will be assessed the first day of class and will be placed appropriately.

Snowplow Sam Classes – Levels 1 – 3

Beginning level classes for skaters ages 3-6. The emphasis in these classes is on fun and enjoyment in skating while learning beginner skating skills.

Basic Skills Classes – Levels 1 – 8

Beginning level classes for skaters ages 7 and up. The emphasis in these levels is enjoyment and basic skill development.

Freestyle Classes – Levels 1 – 6, Advanced

Advanced instruction for skaters who have passed through the basic skills levels and are interested in figure skating (jumps and spins). The Advanced class will provide instruction on figure skating skills beyond Freestyle 6.



Synchronized Team – Levels 1 and 2

Synchronized skating is a team of skaters, skating on the ice at the same time moving as a group in unison through various formations. The formations include lines, blocks, wheels, circles and intersections. The synchronized skating team will also participate in the shows!!! Team 2 is for skaters Basic 2 – 5; Team 1 is for skaters who are Basic 6 and above.

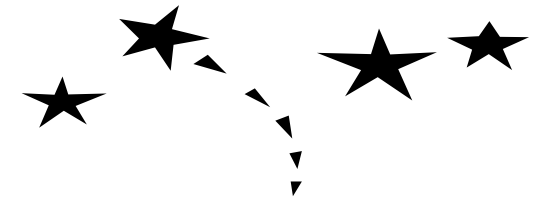
Accelerated

These classes are advanced instruction for skaters who are in Basic 2 - 8 and are interested in figure skating (jumps and spins). Skaters must be enrolled in a basic skills class concurrently.

Adult – Levels 1-4

Beginning level classes for the adult skater who would like to learn the basics of ice skating.
