District Overtime

District quarterfinals, semi-finals & finals will be played to conclusion. The following procedure will be utilized:

- 10 minute sudden death periods until a winner is determined. First goal wins (sudden death).
- Ice will be resurfaced at the referee's discretion.
- Teams will not change ends.
- Two minutes will be allowed between periods.

It was discussed and understood that this will require the District to allocate more ice for games and that this will be reflected in the fee structure.

Exceptions/Waivers

Exception letters must be turned in by November 15th. These letters are only needed for teams that have been flagged by Rick. Coaching Waivers are due before December 31st.

Bylaws/Drafts

Association draft rules, draft schedules and by-laws must be submitted to the District Council for review. This is mandatory. The district must submit to the executive board. Please get them to Mickey as soon as possible.

Coaching & Referee Clinics

Clinic dates were reviewed. They are also available on the MAHA and District 2 websites. The renewal process was discussed. Doug Diroff to contact Jack Witt to find out if there will be renewal clinics offered.

New Business

There has been a committee formed of District Chairpersons to come up with a proposed change regarding the definition and creation of a new association. Currently the rule allows for an association to consist of one team and one player in IP. They will be drafting the rule change and submitting for consideration at the Winter MAHA Meeting.
