### Rules

By Laws – Get by laws submitted to the district so that they can be reviewed prior to next year. The MAHA rules for Associations were changed at last years summer meeting and may require some changes to individual Association By-Laws. Draft rules should either be part of the By-Laws or incorporated by reference and submitted as well.

### Awards

Requests for season awards (Hat Trick, Playmaker, Shutout) need to be turned into Rick. These are being picked up and returned slowly and should be taken care of asap.

### Fees

Spring Fees are \$35.00 per team. These need to be paid by 3 separate checks (an association can pay for all teams but it must still be by 3 separate checks). The checks are for \$20.00 (payable to USA Hockey), \$10.00 (payable to USA Hockey), and \$5.00 (payable to MAHA).

In the fall, player and coach IMR's will be \$30.00 each. This will cover all individual fees, team fees and the new statewide D & O insurance. Registration for fall will also be done on-line for individuals.

Registrars may want to look at purchasing the bar code readers to assist with registration. They are available through USA Hockey for a fee.
