Registration:

Add on registrations should be coming to a close soon. Associations need to be careful when adding on 2nd year players to house teams. Some have recently added 2nd year players without referring to the MAHA sliding scale.

District Intent forms still need to be turned for Taylor Sq. B, Wyandotte Sq. B and Dearborn. If they are not in Rick's hands by 11/22/06, those teams will be disqualified from district competition.

Teams that have been flagged for exceptions need to get their exception letter completed and turned into Rick prior to the State Tournament Committee Meeting on Dec. 9th. Teams flagged for less than 3 teams in a division are in the normal registration drop box.

Risk Management:

Need to have a copy of each association's ice contracts be turned into Debbie Beattie. This is for review by the MAHA Executive Board to ensure that the rinks are not adding additional burden on the associations. So far, contracts have only been received from Allen Park, Lincoln Park and Grosse Ile. Please do this ASAP.

ACE Coordinators

Any coaches who requested a waiver to take level 1 & 2 CEP classes in the same season should get a copy of their coaching cards to Debbie Beatty. Waivers can't be granted without copies of the CEP cards.

For credentials, teams must have the original coaching cards available for review. Too many times a poor copy has resulted in problems during the quarter-finals, semi's and finals when the coach is asked to show the card. An exception to this for teams that have games scheduled the night of the credential review. Debbie will meet with each exception individually at a different time to review their cards.

Tier 1 national bound tournament will be February 28th to March 4th, 2007 in Taylor. Five (5) teams will be participating. Tier II non national bound will be held March 9-11th, 2007 in Marquette.

District Scheduling & Rule Changes

Three separate issues were proposed for change:

1. Going to running time in the Semi's and Finals.
2. Playing State Tournament Format (times) for round robbing games.
3. Placing ranked teams into different pools or divided equally into the available pools so that all ranked teams are not in the same division.

Discussion was held and proposals were approved as follows:

1. State format will apply for all round robin games in travel.
2. State format will apply for all round robin games in the Midget B & BB divisions.
3. Squirt – Bantam B will continue with (3) 10 minute periods.
4. For Semi-final and Final games, running time will start in the 3rd period if there is a 7 goal differential. At anytime that the differential gets to within 3 goals, stop time start again.

District scheduling will be December 2nd the DISC. The D2 web page will be updated on 11/22/2006 with the specific scheduling times.
