"Put Your Disability On Ice"

November 6 - 8, 2009

Eagle Mount provides therapeutic and recreational activities for children and adults with physical, mental, or behavior challenges, striving to improve the quality of life for them and their families.

This clinic is provided by USA Disabled Hockey program called the "One Kid...One Sled...One Shot...A Hockey Player for Life!" This program is designed to help bring new players into the sport of sled hockey by initiating a loaner sled program for rinks and organizations who want to conduct "Learn to Play Sled Hockey" clinics, but were prevented from doing so due to the lack of sleds and sticks needed to conduct such introductory clinics.

What is Sled Hockey



Sled or sledge hockey was invented at a Stockholm, Sweden rehabilitation center in the early 1960's by a group of Swedes who despite their physical disability, wanted to continue playing hockey. Players sit in specially designed sleds that sit on top of two hockey skate blades.

There are two sticks for each player to use. One end of the stick has an ice pick for propulsion on the ice while the other end is used for handling the puck.

Sled Hockey is similar to regular hockey in that the games are played on a standard hockey rink with regulation goals.
