



## Idaho Amateur Hockey Association Referee Game Report

### Part I: Instructions

1. This form is to be used by IAHA officials to document all game-related incidents that result in the assessment of **MATCH PENALTIES** to one or more players during the same stoppage of play.
2. Use a separate form to record all penalties assessed during a single stoppage in play. These include all penalties that lead up to or otherwise relate to the **MATCH** penalty(s). Use a separate form for each separate incident (stoppage of play).
3. The Referee (in the one referee-two linesmen system) or the Senior Referee (in the two-referee system) is responsible for completing all game reports.
