SHARED TOLERANCE APPRECIATION RESPECT

As a Greater Nashville Area Scholastic Hockey (check all that apply prior to signing)

I WILL promote the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of any personal motivation.

I WILL remember that each athlete plays hockey for his/her enjoyment, not mine.

I WILL encourage good sportsmanship through my actions, by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials, parents, and spectators.

I WILL provide support for coaches, parents, volunteer team and league personnel, and officials working with the athletes to provide a positive experience for all.

I WILL demand (require) that athletes under my influence treat all players, coaches, officials, parents, and spectators with respect, regardless of race, creed, color, sex, or ability.

I WILL treat all players, coaches, volunteer team and league personnel, officials, parents, and spectators with dignity and respect in language, attitude, behavior, and mannerisms.

I WILL inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of any athlete or the safety of others.

I WILL respect the property and equipment used at any sports facility, both home and away.

I WILL inform any of my immediate family members that attend or participate in GNASHockey events of this Code of Conduct and their responsibilities to abide by its tenants.

I UNDERSTAND that my behavior or the behavior of any immediate family member may be deemed in violation of the S.T.A.R. Code of Conduct by the Greater Nashville Area Scholastic Hockey League Commissioner or Executive Committee and can be subject to an investigation and hearing by a Greater Nashville Area Scholastic Hockey Disciplinary Committee.

I ACKNOWLEDGE that the GNASHockey Disciplinary Committee has the authority to assess any penalties up to and including exclusion from participation and/or attendance of any GNASHockey event for behavior deemed by GNASHockey to be in violation of this Code of Conduct.

I WILL voluntarily abide by decisions of a Greater Nashville Area Scholastic Hockey Disciplinary Committee.

CONDUCT SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINE

Making physical contact with any player, coach, official, league representative, arena personnel, or spectator.

Taunting or threatening any player, coach, official, league representative, arena personnel, or spectator.

Going into the locker/dressing room of an opposing team or obstructing their access to said room.

Going into the officials' locker/dressing room or obstructing their access to said room.

Using profane and/or vulgar language or mannerisms.

Going onto the ice surface.

Throwing of any object onto the ice surface.

Pounding or climbing on the glass.

Defacing or destroying property belonging to any individual, team, association, or arena.

Being involved in any activity that would warrant the summoning of law enforcement officials.

Inciting any person(s) to become involved in any of the above behaviors.

Any other conduct that is not in compliance with the tenets of the S.T.A.R. Hockey program.
