The Colorado Roller Hockey Association (CRHA) is a group of league/facility directors and community based organization representatives who work together for the common goal of growing the sport of inline hockey in Colorado. The CRHA meets monthly to discuss topics ranging from recruitment and retention of new and existing participants, to marketing/promotion of inline hockey. The meetings also allow for leagues, facilities, directors and participants to pull together their collective resources and build beneficial working relationships which will ultimately benefit the roller hockey participants throughout Colorado.

In an attempt to promote inter-facility play and create a positive atmosphere where an inline hockey player of any skill level can play against teams of similar skill make-up, the CRHA has developed a 4 part tournament series which provides an opportunity for every participant and every team to come play.

While outside tournament series' traditionally focus on elite players whom only make up 10-15% of the inline community, the CRHA operated tournaments provide an avenue for both the competitive player and the recreational player. To help ensure that teams compete against teams of similar skill make-up, the CRHA facilities will work together to place teams in the appropriate skill level.

So what else makes CRHA events unique? Check out the General Tournament Info. below:

Team fee: \$475 for youth teams and \$300 for adult teams

Levels of Play: Competitive & Recreational (including Park & Rec.)

Divisions: 8u, 10u, 12u, 14u, 16u, 18u, Girls/Women & Adult 30 & Over

Av's Tickets: Each youth team registered per event will receive 2 tickets to a designated Avalanche game.

Awards: 1st & 2nd Place Teams

of Games: 4 Game Guarantee

Game Format: Two 12-minute stop-time halves. Games scheduled every 45-minutes. There may be Friday night games.

Advancement: To participate in the Finals, a team must play in at least one qualifier.

Placement: The facilities will work together to determine which level each team will be placed in.
